

## Our Lady of Lourdes Alcohol Policy

- 1) Alcoholic beverages may not be permitted, i.e. neither sold, served, nor tolerated at any event primarily organized for youth. A youth event is defined as any event which would not occur without the presence of youth. Thus, for example, alcohol should not be sold at a grade school or high school basketball game, but could be sold at a parish dinner.
- 2) Private parties, wedding parties and anniversary parties are permitted to serve alcohol but are not allowed to sell alcohol.
- 3) The parish is not permitted to provide the services of a bartender or waitresses for a private party.
- 4) The parish management team of Our Lady of Lourdes shall review the list of all organizations granted permission to sell alcoholic beverages in the month of April, to determine their eligibility for the next calendar year.
- 5) When the sale of alcohol is approved for an event the following will be observed:
  - A) All state and federal laws concerning the sale of alcohol must be strictly observed.
  - B) A temporary liquor permit (F or F2) must be purchased when alcoholic beverages are sold.
  - C) Signs must be posted stating clearly that no one under the age of 21 years of age is to serve, purchase, and or be served alcoholic beverages.
  - D) If there is any doubt about a person's age, the seller or server must ask for identification.
  - E) If it is clear that a person is intoxicated, then he or she must be refused service and offered a ride home.
  - F) Signs must be posted prohibiting anyone from bringing alcohol onto the premises.
  - G) Non-alcoholic beverages must be made available for purchase.
  - H) Workers selling and or serving alcohol must be aware and accept the regulations stated above.
