

# Our Lady of Lourdes Parish Tuition Grant and Aid Program

**TUITION GRANT:** Full student tuition at OLL is \$4,650. The Parish Tuition Grant is the amount the parish community subsidizes the cost of tuition for families who actively participate in the liturgical life of the parish. This year that grant is \$1,600. To qualify for the grant, your participation in the liturgical life of the parish must be described in the space below. **TUITION AID:** *Tuition aid is limited to families whose participation in the liturgical life of the parish can be documented for a minimum of 6 months.* Families applying for tuition aid will need to complete an application (along with the \$28.00 application fee) and submit the necessary supporting documentation to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment by **March 31<sup>st</sup>**. Families can apply online by going to the FACTS link on our website at [www.lourdes.org](http://www.lourdes.org) under **Our School & Alumni>Prospective Family/Student>Registration** or go directly to the following URL: <https://online.factsmgmt.com/signin/4HJ28>. All applications must be done online, and an APPLICANT ID number will be assigned. All tax and supporting documentation can be uploaded to FACTS in a pdf format.

Once the online application has been completed, the following information will need to be sent to FACTS to complete the process:

1. Copies of your most recent Federal tax forms including all supporting tax schedules.
2. Copies of your W-2 forms for both you and your spouse.
3. Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food stamps, Workers' Compensation, and TANF.
