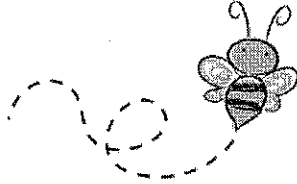

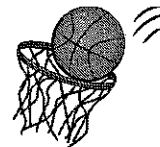


From the Stage:
