

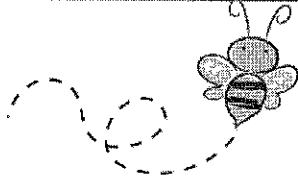

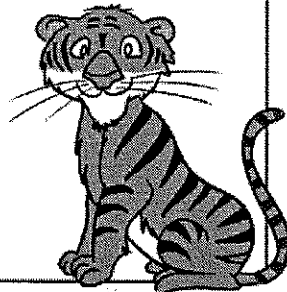
A Note from Ms. B
