Dear Parents/Guardians:

Thank you for your cooperation during the kindergarten assessment process. The information is helpful in allowing us to understand each child's specific skills which will contribute to making the coming school year successful. Your child's skills indicated he/she is ready for a great start in kindergarten.

In order to better facilitate the start of kindergarten, please note and save the following important information.

**SPECIAL SNACKS-** Each child will take a turn in providing the class with a snack during his/her "Super Kid" week and again on his/her birthday. Some suggestions would be grapes, muffins, rice-krispies treat, popcorn, pretzels, and cheese and crackers. Use your imagination! Your child might, also, be asked to contribute a snack for a food related experience throughout the year. **Watch for your child's name and snack turn on your monthly calendar for birthday and super kid only. (Your child's name will appear in the box on the day in which he/she should bring snack.) Please include enough snacks for each student and send snacks that are easily served (no sheet cake); treat bags for birthdays are discouraged.** A special snack is sufficient. You will receive a calendar for the month of August/September the first day of school.

**DAILY SNACKS-**On days that snack is not provided by the birthday student or super kid, you will need to provide one nutritious snack for your child. This should not be a dessert item or bags of chips of any sort, rather something nutritious; for example, fruit, cheese and crackers, popcorn, pretzels, or veggies.

\*\*\*\*\* SNACK DRINK MONEY OPTIONAL\*\*\*\*\*

**Drink money will be \$65.00. Please return this in an envelope with amount enclosed. Please send checks (no cash) made payable to O.L.L. This money covers morning snack drink only, not lunch drink. Send this drink money with your child's school supplies at Open House. If you choose to opt out of the snack drink, your child will be able to get water from the fountain after the snack break.**

**SUPPLIES-**Kindergarten will supply many materials your child will need this year. It is required that your child have a **large backpack labeled clearly with your child's name on the outside.** Please include one pair of underwear and change of pants kept in a ziplock baggie and kept in your child's backpack for emergencies.

**MONEY, NOTES, ETC-** Please be sure every time money, forms, etc.; are sent to school they are in a sealed envelope with your child's name, amount enclosed, and purpose written on the front.

**ABSENCES** must be called into the school office by 8:30 a.m. and documented with a note upon return to school.

**KINDERGARTEN-** A staggered entrance is planned for August 23 and 24. You will be notified in August by mail of your child's starting date and your child should only attend that day; not both. Dismissal for these two days will be 1:00 p.m. as is the entire school. No PM bus service on these days.

**ALL CHILDREN ATTEND BEGINNING FRIDAY, AUGUST 25. There is 1 PM dismissal and NO afternoon bus service.**

**The school hours are 7:45 a.m.-2:30 p.m.**

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

**CAR POOLS A.M.-** Please follow the carpool line in the cafeteria lot for morning drop off. Your child will be escorted into the building by eighth graders until a routine is formed. On the first day of school, you may park and walk your child to his/her classroom. **Children may arrive anytime between 7:30 a.m. and 7:45 a.m. Children must be inside the building at 7:45 a.m. or they will be marked tardy.**

**BUS A.M.-** Your child will be dropped off and escorted into the building. If your child will be a regular rider on the bus, please inform the teacher of your child's name and bus number.

**DISMISSAL-ALL** car riders will be dismissed to the cafeteria parking lot at 2:25 p.m. The Kindergarten teacher will dismiss the kindergartners a few minutes earlier than the rest of the grades to ensure students reach their parents. Parents should park and walk to the picnic table area to pick up your child. Bus riders will be escorted to their bus.
